Media Guidelines

Your media visa issued by the Republic of Nauru is for the specific purpose of reporting on the 49th Pacific Island Forum (PIF) and is subject to the following guidelines. The safety and security of citizens and residents on Nauru is paramount and as such, any breach of these guidelines may result in the visa being revoked, or other measures deemed necessary.

- You must obey the laws of the Republic of Nauru.
- You must follow any lawful instruction issued by a representative of the Government of Nauru or the Nauru Police Force (this includes directives to move along and to cease video or photo activity).
- You are only authorised to report on, or take photos or video of, the PIF. Any other subjects must be approved by the RON
- You must not travel to or visit restricted areas. This is for the safety and security of residents.
- No video or photo may be taken of any resident on Nauru who is an asylum seeker, to protect their personal safety (this is standard global practice).
- As a security measure during PIF, the use of drones is strictly prohibited.
- As a security measure, media passes must be worn at ALL times while on Nauru, so you are clearly identifiable.
- Refrain from interviewing Canstruct and other contractor staff as they have signed confidentiality agreements, and your cooperation will ensure they are not subjected to any discord with their employer
